## Sense of Place Suikerboschrand 2017

### Tasting Notes:

A voluptuous and complex Cape Blend, with an abundance of ripe berry fruit, dark chocolate and cigar box aromas. The wood flavours of the carefully selected oak barrels complement the wine beautifully and support the structure of the wine. The elegant tannins ensure a lingering aftertaste with a fresh hint of spices.

### The Harvest:

The grapes were hand-picked at optimum ripeness to ensure that the best qualities of the cultivars are represented in the final blend.

### Serve with:

Best enjoyed with red meats, whether grilled, roasted or smoked as well as creamy dishes.

### In the Cellar:

All components were vinified separately. The wine was fermented and aged in 100% new French oak barrels for 24 months.

### Ageing Potential:

This wine will age well in the bottle for 8 to 10 years.

### Blend:

40% Pinotage, 30% Shiraz, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot
