Polkadraai Chenin/Sauvignon Blanc 2024

Tasting Notes :

Star bright with a green undertone. An easy-to-drink, well-balanced blend.
The wine is grassy on the nose, with tropical fruit flavours on the palate.

Serve with:

Al fresco lunches, cold cucumber soup, sushi and grilled chicken.

Serve chilled.

The Harvest :

All the grapes come from the Polkadraai area, in Stellenbosch. Both varietals were harvested early, to preserve the zesty character of the wine, as well as the tropical flavours.

In the Cellar:

The two varietals were vinified separately and blending took place after fermentation.

Ageing Potential:

Enjoy now or within two years from vintage

Blend:

70% Chenin blanc

30% Sauvignon blanc
